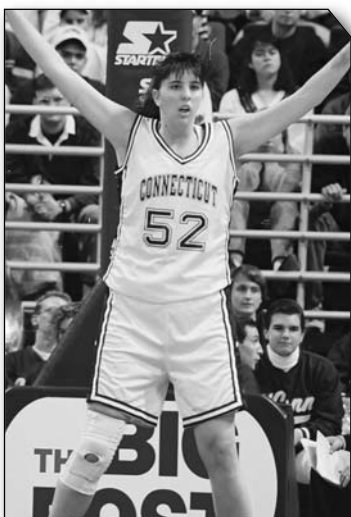

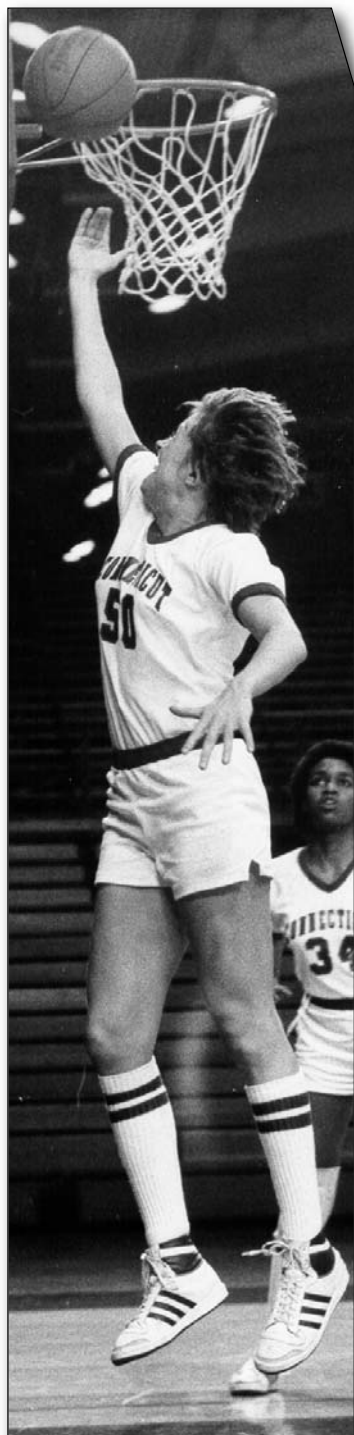

Academic All-America Hall of Fame

Dr. Leigh Curl '85

1998 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE: Dr. Leigh Curl was inducted into the GTE/CoSIDA Academic All-America Hall of Fame on June 10, 1998.

Curl, a two-time Academic All-America choice, was a basketball standout at the University of Connecticut (1981-1985). Curl, who scored 1,388 points in her career, was only the third woman in Connecticut history to score 1,000 points and is currently No. 18 at UConn in career points.

The four-year starter and two-year captain was also Summa Cum Laude in biology and the valedictorian of her graduating class at UConn. Curl was also the 1985 BIG EAST Scholar-Athlete and the UConn Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete.

One professor at Connecticut saw her potential and thought she was bound for bigger and better things - Dr. Ted Taigen. Curl did her honors thesis in Taigen's lab and there he noticed her talent and aptitude in biology. Taigen talked her into applying to medical school.

Curl was accepted into Johns Hopkins School of Medicine where she got her degree while volunteering as a team physician for USA Basketball and the New York City public schools recreation program.

Currently the head team physician for the 2001 NFL Super Bowl Champions Baltimore Ravens, Curl is only the sixth woman ever to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. The other 1998 inductees were: Bernie Kosar (Miami), Jack Mildren (Oklahoma), Jack Sikma (Illinois Wesleyan) and Marv Levy (Coe College).

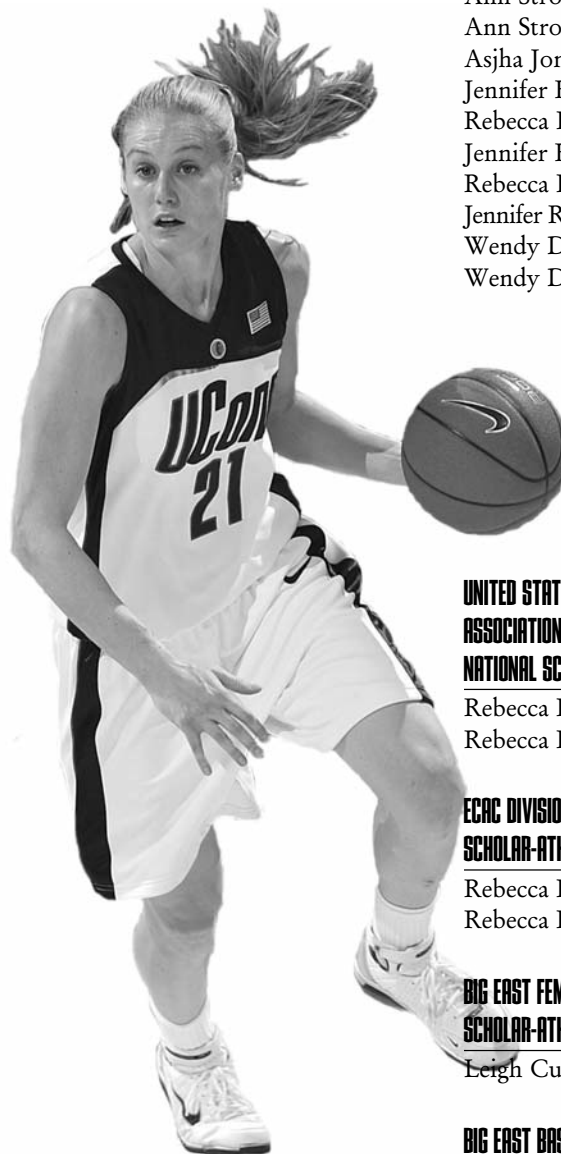

Since the 1993-94 season, UConn has played before 2,641,789 fans in 259 home games (186 in the Harry A. Gampel Pavilion and 73 in the Hartford Civic Center).

UConn has led the nation in average attendance during three seasons and has led the nation in games played before the highest percentage of capacity in every season since 1995.
