UConn Wins BIG EAST 15th BIG EAST Regular Season Title

ADVANCE TO REGIONALS FOR 14TH CONSECUTIVE YEAR

2007 LEADS HUSKIES TO FRESNO FOR 14TH STRAIGHT NCAA REGIONAL: The Huskies earned their 14th consecutive trip to the regional round of the NCAA Tournament in 2007 where it defeated North Carolina State before falling to LSU, after advancing to the NCAA Regional Final for the second straight season and the seventh time in the past eight years.

Connecticut has won 26 of its last 29 games in the NCAA Tournament and has posted an overall mark of 13-2 in NCAA Semifinal contests, including its 2006-07 win over N.C. State.

UConn has now posted an overall mark of 36-4 in NCAA Tournament games dating back to the 2000 season.

UCONN BOASTS FIFTH-LONGEST NCAA TOURNEY STREAK: The Huskies, who are made their 19th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in 2007, owns the third-longest active streak for NCAA berths and the fifth-longest all-time.

Only Tennessee, who has qualified for 26 straight, and Stanford, who made 20 straight NCAA Tournaments, have longer active streaks than UConn.

30 WINS AGAIN: With its NCAA Tournament first round win over UMBC, UConn wrapped up a 30-win season for the 12th time in the program's history - all since Geno Auriemma has been head coach.

The Huskies have won 30 games in 12 of the last 14 seasons overall with the lone exceptions coming in 2005 (25 wins) and 1999 (29 wins).

20 WINS ONCE AGAIN: UConn's 51-48 win over Marquette on Feb. 3 secured the 14th consecutive season and marked the 18th time in the program's history that UConn has registered 20 wins in a season - all have come under head coach Geno Auriemma.

BACK TO PERFECTION IN BIG EAST: The Huskies 16-0 mark in BIG EAST Conference play marked its sixth perfect season in conference play and its first since 2002-03.

CHAMPS AGAIN AFTER A SHORT HIATUS: Connecticut claimed the 15th BIG EAST Regular Season Championship in the program's history and its 12th outright crown with its 81-67 win over South Florida on Feb. 20.

The title marks UConn's first since 2004 and its 12th in the last 14 seasons.



AURIEMMA JOINS 600 CLUB: UConn head coach Geno Auriemma became the 14th active and 17th coach all-time to reach the 600-win milestone in UConn's win over Sacred Heart on Dec. 31.

GENO FASTEST TO 600: UConn head coach Geno Auriemma became the fastest coach in NCAA Division I women's basketball history to reach 600 career wins in terms of both seasons and games needed as he notched the milestone win on Dec. 31 vs. Sacred Heart at the Hartford Civic Center.

Auriemma took just 716 games to reach 600 career victories - 18 games faster than the previous quickest to the mark, Tennessee's Pat Summitt who took 734 games over 23 seasons to reach 600 career wins.

AURIEMMA NAMED NAISMITH NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR FINALIST:

UConn head coach Geno Auriemma was selected as one of four finalists for the 2007 Naismith National Coach of the Year along with Tennessee's Pat Summitt, Duke's Gail Goestenkors and Texas A&M's Gary Blair.

Auriemma has also won the prestigious Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year award four times previously (1995, 1997, 2000 and 2002).

The Naismith Award is the most prestigious national award presented annually to the men's and women's college basketball coaches of the year.

HIGHEST RANKING SINCE...:

Connecticut's No. 2 ranking in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Coaches Polls during the week of March 5 marked the program's highest ranking since the last week they held the No. 1 spot "in" season on Feb. 23, 2004.

UConn finished the season ranked No. 4 in the Associated Press and No. 5 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Polls following the 2007 NCAA Tournament.

UCONN JOINS 700 CLUB: UConn's 70-60 win at Cincinnati on Jan. 30 marked the Huskies' 700th win in the 32-plus year history of the program.

The Huskies are the 18th team in NCAA Division I women's basketball history to garner 700 wins joining Louisiana Tech, Tennessee, Texas, Old Dominion, James Madison, Stephen F. Austin, Tennessee Tech, Long Beach State, Penn State, Ohio State, Richmond, Western Kentucky, Texas Tech, Kansas State, Georgia, Auburn and Stanford.

UCONN FIRST SCHOOL WITH 300 BIG EAST WINS:

The Huskies boast an overall record of 316-83 (.792) in regular-season BIG EAST games - the first conference school in history to record 300 league wins in history.

Only one other school in BIG EAST history has managed to reach 200 wins in conference play - as Villanova currently boasts 230 wins following the completion of the 2006-07 season.

THREE DOUBLES-DOUBLES FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 1994:

Tina Charles (15 pts., 10 rebs.), Kalana Greene (15 pts., 10 rebs.) and Charde Houston (16 pts., 11 rebs.) each recorded a double-double in UConn's 60-50 win over Rutgers on Feb. 6 - marking the first time that three Huskies have registered a double-double in the same game since Jan. 9, 1994 vs. Georgetown - a span of 476 games.

Jamelle Elliott (12 pts./10 rebs), Rebecca Lobo (22 pts./17 rebs) and Kara Wolters (14 pts./10 rebs) were the last to turn the trick on Jan. 9, 1994 against Georgetown.

100/100/100 CLUB FOR HOUSTON:

Junior Charde Houston joined an elite club at UConn with her first two blocks in UConn's win over St. John's on Jan 21 as she became the seventh player in UConn annals to register 100 steals, blocks and assists in a career.

Houston's third of four steals in UConn's win at Holy Cross on Dec. 4 marked the 100th of her career.

In addition, Houston reached 100 assists with her first of two at North Carolina on Jan. 15.

She becomes the seventh player in UConn annals to reach 100 in steals, assists and blocks in a career joining Rebecca Lobo (396 blocks/130 steals/260 assists), Diana Taurasi (147/174/648), Swin Cash (130/148/175), Asjha Jones (151/119/194), Jessica Moore (125/104/167) and Ann Strother (120/119/418).

Each of the seven players have also registered 1,000 points in their careers.

CHARLES 19 BOARDS A FRESHMAN MARK: Tina Charles 19 rebounds vs. Syracuse on Jan. 13 marked the most-ever by a UConn freshman since Geno Auriemma became coach in 1985-86.

The last time a UConn player had more than 20 rebounds came when Swin Cash pulled down 20 on Feb. 20, 2001 vs. West Virginia - a span of 206 games.

ALL FIVE IN DOUBLE-DIGITS: All five UConn starters averaged double-figure points during the 2006-07 season - and five different players led the Huskies in scoring during individual games over the course of the season.

UConn has had five players finish in double-figure points just two other times in its history, the most recent during 2001-02 season which saw the Huskies finish 39-0.

The only other season that UConn has had five players in double-figures was the 1994-95 campaign which culminated in the first national championship and a 35-0 mark.

Reserve Nykesha Sales averaged double-digits off the bench to give the Huskies five players in double-digits.
