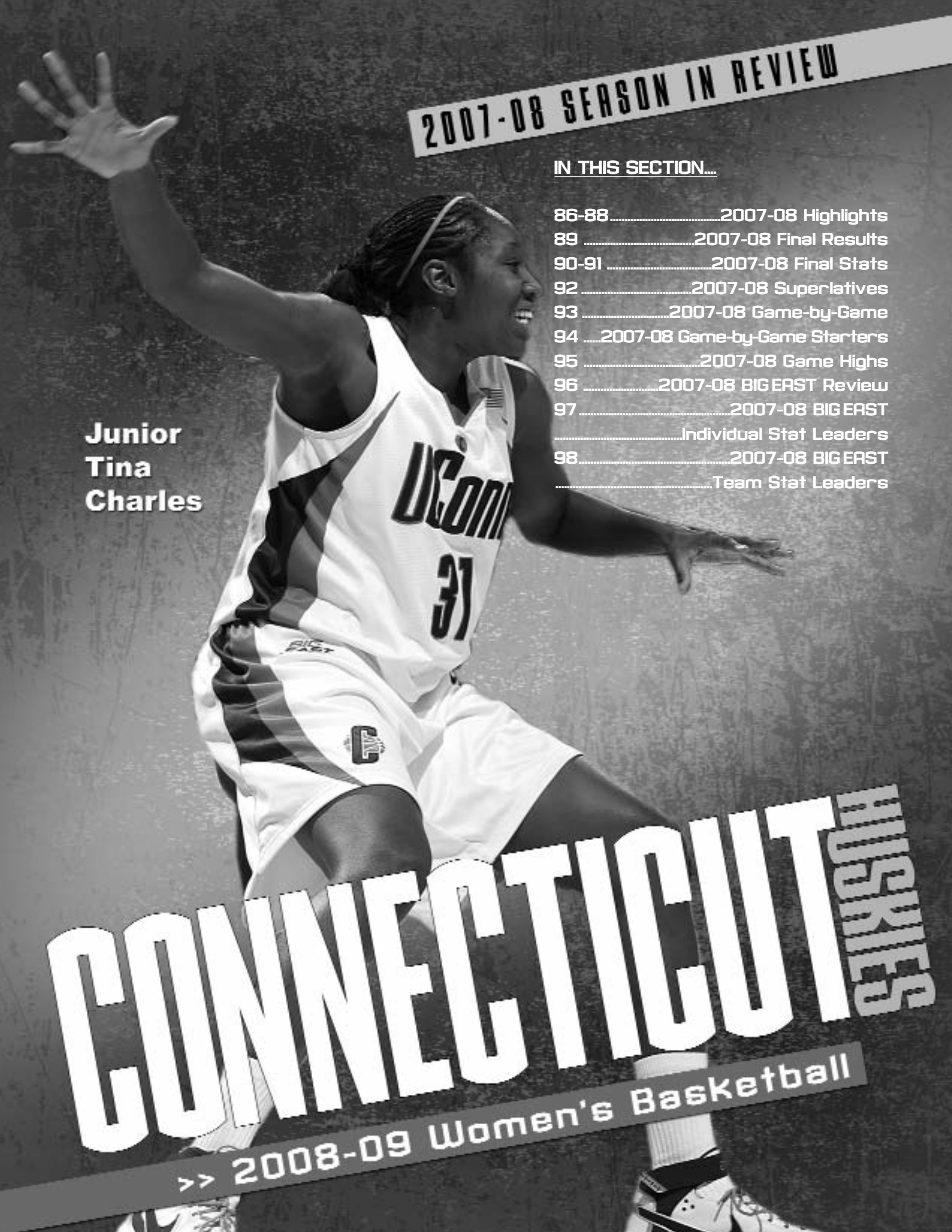

# UConn Returns to Final Four For Ninth Time

## HUSKIES ALSO NAB BIG EAST REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNEY TITLES

**HUSKIES RETURN TO FINAL FOUR FOR NINTH TIME:** Connecticut earned its ninth berth in the NCAA Final Four in 2008 and its first since 2004. The Huskies defeated Cornell, Texas, Old Dominion and Rutgers to earn the trip to Tampa.

Connecticut has won 30 of its last 33 games in the NCAA Tournament and has posted an overall mark of 5-4 in NCAA National Semifinal contests.

UConn has now posted an overall mark of 40-5 in NCAA Tournament games dating back to the 2000 season.

**UConn Boasts Fifth-Longest NCAA Tourney Streak:** The Huskies, who are made their 20th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in 2008, own the third-longest active streak for NCAA berths and the fifth-longest all-time.

Only Tennessee, who has qualified for 27 straight, and Stanford, who made 21 straight NCAA Tournaments, have longer active streaks than UConn.

**Huskies + Big East = 30 Titles:** Connecticut has amassed an astounding 30 BIG EAST titles in the program's history following its sweep of both the league reg-

ular season and tournament titles in 2008 - marking the first time since 2002 and the 12th time in the program's history that the Huskies have pulled off the double.

The Huskies followed a 15-1 regular season conference mark (16th title) by winning three straight over DePaul, Pittsburgh and Louisville by an average of 17.3 ppg to claim their 14th BIG EAST Tournament championship.

**Moore Makes Big East History:** UConn freshman Maya Moore made BIG EAST history on at the conference's annual awards banquet in 2008 as she became the first freshman in the league's history (male or female) to be recognized as the BIG EAST Player of the Year.

Moore was also the unanimous choice as the BIG EAST Freshman of the Year, becoming the first player in league history to sweep both awards.

Moore's selection marks the 14th time a UConn player has been named as BIG EAST Player of the Year. The BIG EAST Freshman of the Year Award represents the 10th time a UConn player has been so honored and the third consecutive season overall following Renee Montgomery (2006) and Tina Charles (2007).



Senior guard Ketia Swanier was recognized by the league as the BIG EAST Sixth Man of the Year, the first year of the award.

UConn head coach Geno Auriemma was named Co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year along with Syracuse's Quentin Hillman. Auriemma's selection marked the seventh time he has been selected as the conference's coach of the year and the first time since 2003.

A total of three UConn players were selected to the All-BIG EAST First Team as junior Renee Montgomery and sophomore Tina Charles joined Moore on the 11-member squad.

UConn has now earned a total of 34 selections to the All-BIG EAST First Team in the program's history.

Swanier was also selected as an All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention choice.

Moore and fellow freshman Lorin Dixon were each named to the All-BIG EAST Freshman Team.

All BIG EAST Awards are voted on by the league's 16 head coaches.

**36 WINS:** UConn amassed 36 wins in 2007-08 - marking its highest single-season win total since 2003 and the seventh time in the program's history it has notched at least 34 victories - all since 1995.

UConn has recorded at least 35 wins four previous times overall. UConn won the National Championship the last four times the Huskies recorded at least 35 victories.

**AURIEMMA NAMED WBCA NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR:** Geno Auriemma was named as the recipient of the 2008 Russell/WBCA Division I National Coach of the Year.

This marks the fourth time Auriemma has been recognized by his peers as the National Coach of the Year. Auriemma was previously selected following the 1996-97, 1999-00 and 2001-02 seasons.

During his 23-year head coaching tenure, Auriemma has now garnered a combined total of 18 national coach of the year honors.

Auriemma was also honored as the USBWA National Coach of the Year and the Associated Press National Coach of the Year.

For his career, Auriemma has garnered a total of 19 National Coach of the Year honors.

Despite losing two starters to injury, UConn collected both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the 12th time in the program's history and the first time since 2002.

**MOORE AND MONTGOMERY NAMED STATE FARM/WBCA ALL-AMERICA:** Freshman Maya Moore and junior Renee Montgomery were each named to the 2008 State Farm/WBCA All-America Team which was announced at the site of the 2008 Final Four in Tampa, Fla.

Montgomery and Moore were one of only two pairs of teammates who were so honored, joining Maryland's Kristi Tolliver and Crystal Langhorne.

Moore is the first-ever freshman in UConn history to be named to the squad and both players selections brings UConn's total number of All-America selections to 20.

**MOORE BECOMES SECOND ROOKIE NAMED AP FIRST TEAM ALL-AMERICA:** UConn rookie Maya Moore became the second freshman in NCAA history to be named to the Associated Press All-America First Team.

Moore is only the second freshman in NCAA Division I women's basketball history to be recognized as an Associated Press First Team All-America selection, joining Oklahoma's Courtney Paris.

UConn junior Renee Montgomery and sophomore Tina Charles were each named to the Associated Press Third Team All-America squad, while senior Charde Houston was selected as an honorable mention.

Moore selection marks the 12th time a UConn player has been named to the Associated Press All-America First Team.

Montgomery, Charles and Houston were each named to the Associated All-America Honorable Mention choices last season.

Joining Moore on the first team were Oklahoma's Paris, LSU's Sylvia Fowles, Stanford's Candice Wiggins and Tennessee's Candace Parker.

The second team included a pair of Maryland players in Crystal Langhorne and Kristi Toliver, North Carolina's Erlana Larkins, Louisville's Angel McCoughtry and Oklahoma State's Andrea Riley.

Joining Montgomery and Charles on the third team were Rutgers' Epiphanny Prince, Middle Tennessee State's Amber Holt and Utah's Leilani Mitchell.

**ANOTHER 30-WIN CAMPAIGN:** With its 86-67 win over DePaul in the BIG EAST quarterfinals, Connecticut clinched its third consecutive 30-win season and the 13th in the program's history - all since 1993-94.

UConn has won 30-plus games in 13 of the past 15 seasons overall with the only exceptions coming in 1998-99 and 2004-05.

**MOORE BREAKS BIG EAST FRESHMAN SCORING MARK:** Maya Moore's 678 points are the most ever by a freshman from the BIG EAST Conference - surpassing Tamara James' (Miami, Fla.) previous BIG EAST Freshman record total of 650.

**MOORE TIES DOUBLE-DOUBLE MARK:** Maya Moore's 25 points and 11 rebounds in the NCAA Greensboro Regional Semifinal win over Old Dominion marked her 11th double-double during her rookie season.

Her 11 double-doubles tied for the most by a freshman in UConn and BIG EAST Conference history - with current teammate Tina Charles' record total of 11 - set during the 2006-07 season.

**2008 SENIOR CLASS:** The 2008 UConn senior class of Charde Houston, Brittany Hunter, Ketia Swanier and Mel Thomas compiled an overall mark of 125-19 (.868) mark during their tenure in Storrs.

The trio have won three BIG EAST Tournament titles (2005, 2006, 2008) and captured the last two BIG EAST Regular Season Championship, including posting a perfect 16-0 conference record - the sixth unblemished BIG EAST season in UConn history in 2006-07. The Huskies finished 15-1 in conference play in 2007-08 en route to the title.

The senior class has advanced to the NCAA Regional round in each of their four seasons with two berths in the "Elite Eight" and a "Sweet Sixteen" appearance over the first three prior to clinching a berth in the 2008 NCAA Final Four.

**MOORE BREAKS FRESHMAN SCORING RECORD:** Maya Moore is the is the all-time leading freshman scorer in the program's history.

Moore's 678 points are the most by a UConn freshman surpassing Svetlana Abrosimova's previous UConn freshman scoring record of 538 points.

**THOMAS AND MONTGOMERY HIT 1,000:** UConn junior Renee Montgomery was honored in a pregame ceremony prior to the Huskies' game vs. South Florida on Jan. 30 for becoming the 30th player in UConn history to score 1,000 career points.

Montgomery hit the milestone on Jan. 21 vs. North Carolina.

Senior Mel Thomas became the 29th player in UConn annals to register 1,000 points, hitting the milestone Dec. 5 vs. Virginia. She finished her UConn career with 1,098 career points, which currently ranks 28th-most in the program's history.
